- 3. Stump Grinding** After a tree is removed, the stump remains. Left alone, stumps can suckers (new shoots), attract pests, or simply be a trip hazard and an eyesore. Professional stump grinding machinery can chew the stump down well below surface level, allowing you to turf over the area or replant, effectively reclaiming your garden space.
